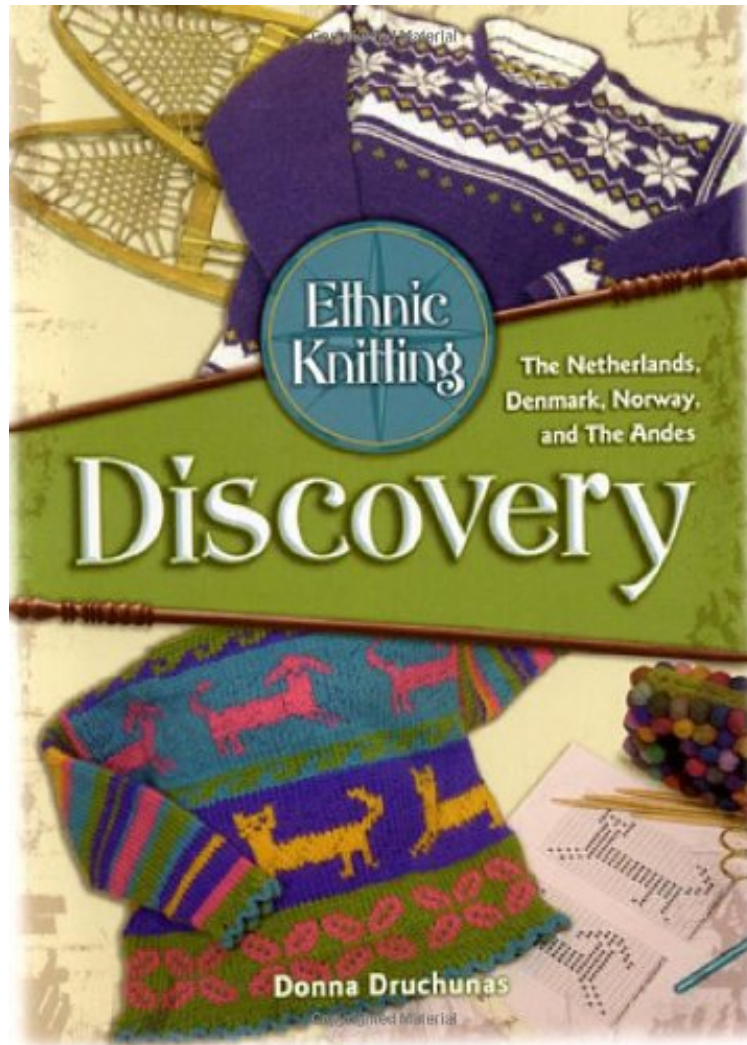

There are no complete instructions to knit any of the patterns. This might encourage the insecure knitter who follows patterns completely to eventually be able to knit without following a

pattern (the more traditional/ethnic method of knitting, we are told).
