Lacking in Instructions/RecipeBy David G BI expected a basic recipe somewhere in Part 1: Guide to Soap Making. The information there was good - instructions for both cold and hot methods of soap making as well as mention of ingredients. The we move to Part 2: Soap Recipes. Nice recipes, calling first for 'Basic melt and pour soap base' where you pour that into a bowl and cover.Where do we obtain that basic soap base? It's not mentioned in Part 1, although there is a chapter "Equipment Supplies You Need." Distilled water, Lye,

color or fragrance (if desired) - but no "How To" on creating that necessary 'Basic melt and pour soap base.'Also, it would have been nice to have photographs of the finished recipes. The front cover looks great - are those from some of the recipes? Which ones?More questions than answers, though I did not learn how to make natural, easy, handmade soap from scratch from this book.4 of 4 people found the following review helpful.
