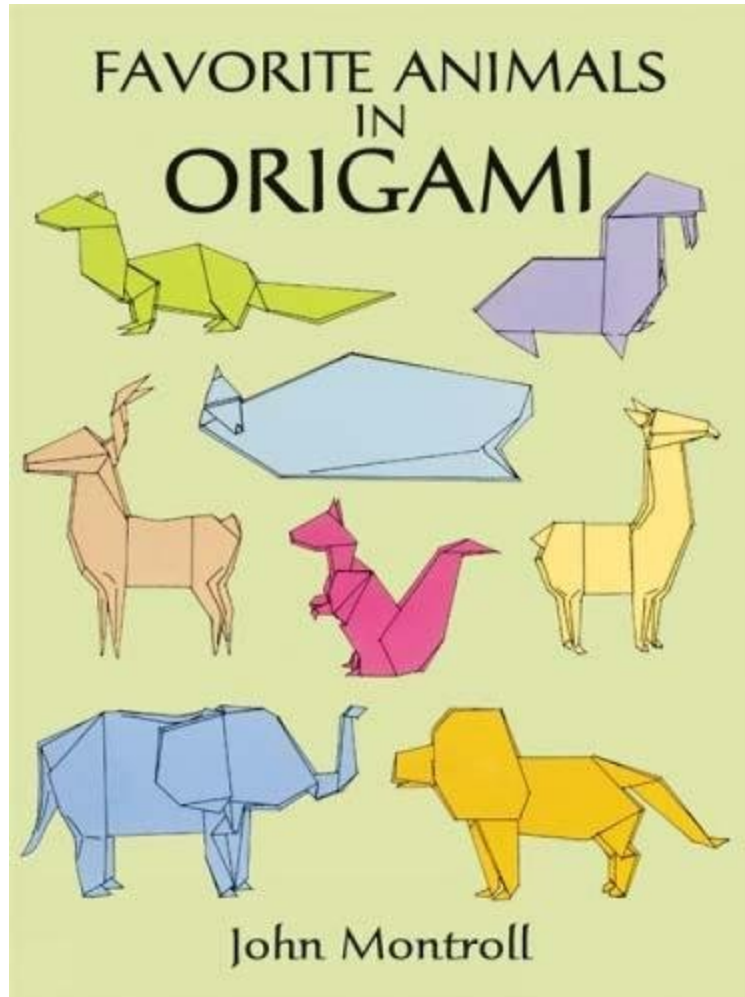

This isn't for beginners or children By Brenda I'm not a fan. The paper is fine, but the instructions are bad. I bought it for my daughter who has loved other origami books before, but the drawings they

show for instructions will flip the paper from one direction to another in the next step without saying so. You're not sure what side or angle you're supposed to be looking at and the different folds aren't clear as to where or how the folds are to be made. Just "flip this way or fold that way", when you really needed to push the fold into the interior of the animal. I gave it one star for the reference. We can look the animals in this book up on youtube. I gave another star for the paper supplied, but I wouldn't recommend this as a tutorial for your children.
