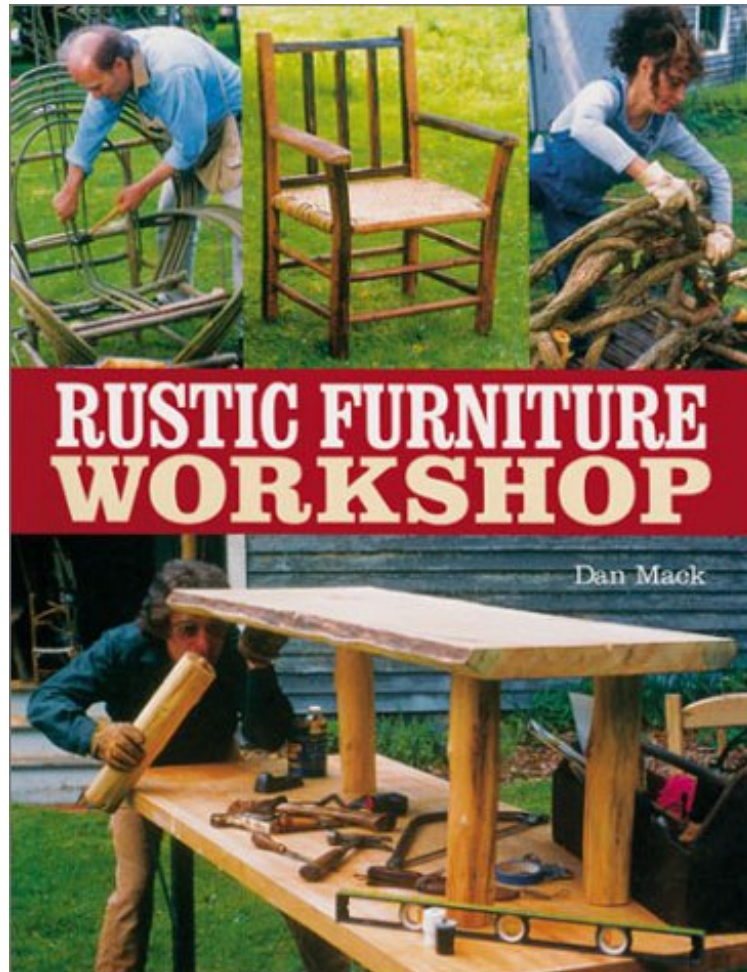

This book provides a good overview of rustic woodworking without going into a lot of project-specific detail. Basic joinery and design are emphasized. If you are already experienced with traditional woodworking, there is enough information here to allow you to get started with rustic pieces. The author's approach of allowing a project to take shape as it is constructed, rather than making highly detailed plans, fits well with the way I like to work.
